We have been learning to recognise and count up and down the numbers 1 to 10.

Here are some number cards to practise at home.

Some ideas to use them:

- Can you recognise the numbers when shown out of order?
- Can you count out the correct amount of objects from a pile to place with the number cards? (eg 3 cars, 4 dolls etc.)
- Can you count a set amount of objects then find the matching card?
- Can you place the numbers in order starting at 1?
- Can you place the numbers in order starting from 10?
- If a card is taken away, can you work out the missing card?
- When you hold up a card, can you say the next number? Can you say the number before?
- Can you write the numbers?
- Can you see the numbers when you are out and about?

We would love to see your child practising and having fun with these cards. Please feel free to create your own Tapestry observations so we can help continue their learning at school.
