- Clubs and enrichment opportunities continue to be offered by the school



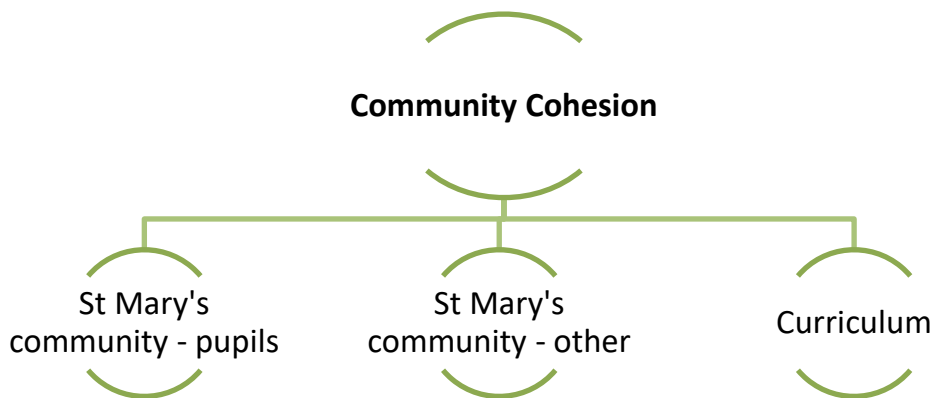
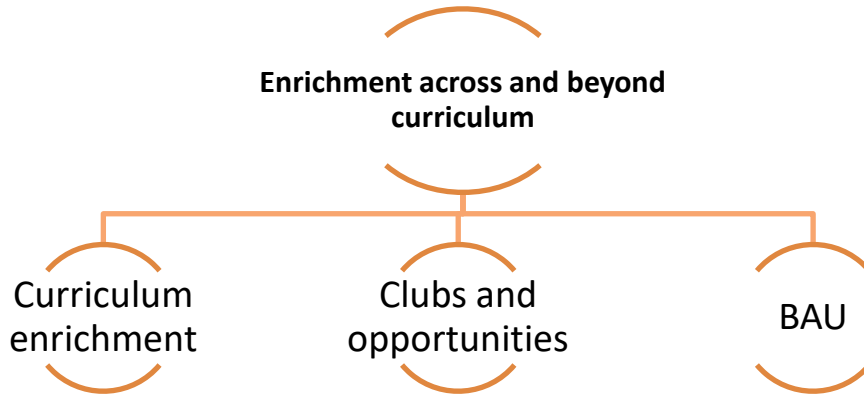
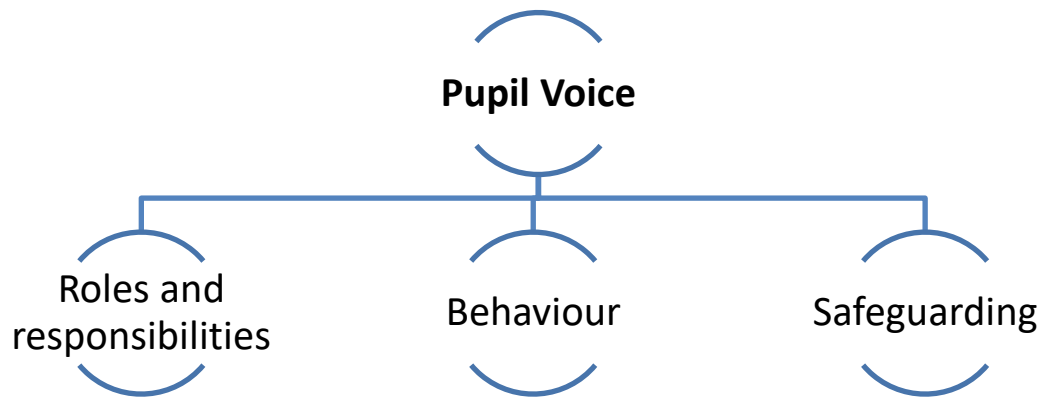
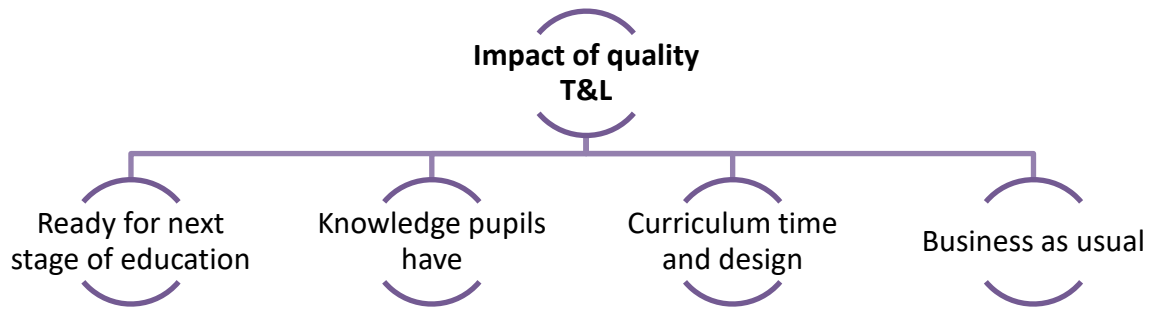
Community Cohesion
